At one point, she handed him a cup of hot tea Another time, she offered her husband a soft drink that had been given to her.

At one point, she scrawled a note to one of her husband's attorneys, who passed it to Mr. Dean. The note read: "I know you're conserving your voice, but be as forceful as possible."
