Will the Real Martha Please Call

Martha Mitchell, calling from somewhere in the South, said yesterday she would not comment on her husband's Watergate testimony "until it's all over," but she said she stands by everything she has said previously about the scandal.

In a call to UPI as her husband, John, began his third day of questioning by the Senate Watergate committee, Mrs. Mitchell also denied telephoning the news service Wednesday to back up his testimony. "I haven't talked to a damned soul," she said. (11402)

"I want you to put out a denial," she said yesterday at around 10 a.m. (EDT) (she said it was 9 a.m. where she was). "I'm sick and tired of people picking up the phone and saying they are Martha Mitchell."
