

In Democratic Civil Suit

WASHINGTON, July 21 (UPI)—The testimony of Ronald L. Ziegler, Presidential press secretary, which had been scheduled for today in a Watergate civil suit, has been postponed indefinitely awaiting a Federal court ruling on how far the questioning may go.

At issue is whether Mr. Ziegler can be forced to answer questions about events following the June 17, 1972, bugging arrests at the Democratic National Committee headquarters.

Lawyers for the Democratic party, which is pressing a \$6.4-million civil damage suit against a number of Watergate principals, said yesterday that they would reschedule the taking of a sworn pre-trial deposition from Mr. Ziegler later.
