

Talmadge Reported

To Have Accepted Trip

WASHINGTON, July 30 —
Senator Herman E. Talmadge,
Democrat of Georgia, who is
a member of the Senate Com-
mittee investigatng the Water-
gate scandals, was reportedly
flown to the Caribbean for a
mid-winter vacation early this
year by a major Government
contractor.

The flight took place Feb.
9, the day after Congress be-
gan a week-long Lincoln's
birthday recess. A reliable
source said that Senator Tal-
madge was aboard a plane
owned and operated by Rock-
well International that flew
from Dulles International Air-
port to the island of Bimini.
Rockwell is a major defense
and aerospace contractor.
