Mansfield Wants Nixon to See Probers

Senate Democratic leader Mike Mansfield yesterday urged President Nixon to hold "an informal meeting" in the White House with the seven members of the Senate Watergate committee.

Noting that White House aides have said Mr. Nixon would respond to testimony and documentary evidence after the first phase of the Senate hearings end next week, Mansfield said:

"I would hope that in addition to making his case to

the people he would be getting together informally with the committee to discuss these matters on which there are differences.

"By informally, I mean a meeting in the White House," the senator added during an interview at his office.

At the same time, Mansfield suggested that everyone wait until the President had responded and all the facts are in before passing judgment on Mr. Nixon's actions.
