

Nixon's Working Weekend at Camp David

President Nixon spent a long, hot summer weekend at his Catocin Mountain retreat reviewing recently passed legislation and working on a public response he will make soon on the Watergate affair.

Deputy press secretary Gerald L. Warren said the President worked throughout the weekend and conferred with staff members by telephone. But he also spent some time relaxing in the sun near the swimming pool. Mr. Nixon returned to the White House last night.

Mrs. Nixon, daughters Patricia Cox and Julie Eisenhower and son-in-law David Eisenhower were at Camp David, too.

Warren said it can be assumed that Mr. Nixon will speak out on Watergate within the next two weeks if the Senate committee concludes its current phase of testimony.
