Cambodia

CAMP DAVID (Md.) — (UPI) — President Nixon summoned foreign policy adviser Henry Kissinger to his mountain retreat yesterday, presumably to discuss the increasingly tense military situation in Cambodia as the United States prepares to halt bombing raids at midnight Tuesday.

Kissinger was accompanied by presidential aide Bryce Harlow to Camp David, where Nixon has been working since Wednesday on his Watergate speech. Deputy press secretary Gerald Warren said the Kissinger-Nixon meeting did not concern Watergate.

The meeting coincided with reports that Cambodian Prince Sihanouk sent a message to the president yesterday. Leadership of the
