

2 Agnew Friends May Testify Against Him

Time magazine reported yesterday that two of Vice President Spiro Agnew's close friends are prepared to testify that the vice president had extorted campaign contributions from Maryland contractors and engineers.

The magazine said that Jerome E. Wolff, a one-time assistant to the vice president and now an official of the J. E. Grainer Co., Inc., a consulting engineering firm, and Lester Matz, a partner in the firm of Matz, Childs & Associates, also a consulting firm, were providing information to federal investigators.
