Ex-Policeman Held in Nixon Plot

ARROYO HONDO, N.M., lieu of \$100,000 bond at Bern-Aug. 22 (AP) — Edwin M. Gaudet, sought in the moun-tains of northern New Mex-tains of northern New Mex-

tains of northern New Mexico nearly three days for allegedly threatening the life of President Nixon, surrendered peacefully today.

Gaudet, 29, a former New Orleans policeman, drove to a police base camp with his wife and cousin, who negotiated his surrender. He told newsmen the "government is organized crime" and was then taken by a Secret Service agent to Albuquerque for arraignment.

Gaudet was held tonight in Strate.

A federal warrant issued in New Orleans that Gaudet, a resident of the buquerque, Gaudet told newsmen, "The government is organized crime. The Pope is the head of the Mafia.
