Ex-Suspect in Nixon Threat Still in Jail

Bond was reduced from \$25,000 to \$10,000, but Edwin M. Gaudet remained in jail last night charged with assault with intent to kill a Taos policeman.

The charge stems from an alleged exchange of gunfire August 20 with police who were pursuing Gaudet on the basis of a federal warrant charging him with threatening the life of President Nixon.

The federal charge later was dropped.

Taos Magistrate Norberto Martinez reduced bond, but Gaudet remained in the Taos county jail, his attorney, John Ramming, said.
