Haldeman's Lawyer Seeks
To Bar Further Testimony

WASHINGTON, Oct. 13 (UPI)

A lawyer for H. R. Haldeman, former Presidential aide, said Saturday* he would seek to keep his client from testifying again before Federal grand Juries looking into 1972 campaign tactics.

Frank H. Strickler said he and John J. Wilson, Mr. Haldeman's other attorney, would ask United States District Court Judge John J. Sirica to quash the grand jury subpoenas requested by the special Watergate prosecutor, Archibald Cox. He said the Government's requests' for Mr. Haldeman's testimony were becoming slightly "oppressive."
