

Ervin Cancels Meeting Of Watergate Committee

WASHINGTON, Oct. 24—
Senator Sam J. Ervin Jr.,
chairman of the Senate Wa-
tergate committee, canceled
today the committee meeting
that was scheduled for to-
morrow.

Senator Ervin, who is at
his home in Morganton, N.C.,
was said to believe that there
was no urgency for a meet-
ing, following President Nix-
on's decision to release the
White House tapes to Judge
John J. Sirica.

The committee's public
hearings are to resume next
Tuesday, and current plans
are for the Senators to meet
privately before the hearings
start.

Meanwhile, a spokesman
for the Public Broadcasting
Service said in New York
that public television stations
would no longer broadcast
the hearings in full each
night.
