Dec. 19 Trial Set

For Ehrlichman

LOS ANGELES, Oct. 26 (UPI)—The trial of John D. Ehrlichman and three other former White House aides on conspiracy and burglary charges was set today for Dec. 19.

Start of the trial, however, could be delayed well beyond that date by arguments over pretrial motions, including one expected from the defense seeking access to presidential tape recordings.

Ehrlichman was indicted in connection with the 1971 break-in at the office of Daniel Ellsberg's psychiatrist along with Egil (Bud) Krogh, David Young and G. Gordon Liddy.

State Superior Court Judge Gordon Ringer set the Dec. 19 starting date, but postponed until Nov. 12 a hearing on evidence discovery motions to be made by lawyers for Ehrlichman and the others.
