

Agnew Pays \$10,000 Tax Fine

Former Vice President Spiro T. Agnew has paid the \$10,000 court fine imposed upon him after he pleaded no contest to a tax evasion charge.

U.S. Attorney George Beall of Maryland told the Justice Department that he received Agnew's personal certified check in the mail yesterday.

Agnew, who resigned from office October 10 in a compromise with federal prosecutors, was also sentenced to three years of unsupervised probation after he entered the no contest plea.
