Impeachment Petition Signed
By 15,000 in O'Neill Area

BOSTON, Nov. 1 (UPI)—A coalition of political groups says it has gathered 15,000 signatures on a petition calling for impeachment of President Nixon in the district of the House majority whip, Representative Thomas P. O'Neill, Democrat of Massachusetts.

A spokesman, John Roberts of the Civil Liberties Union of Massachusetts, said that the group was "extremely pleased" with the result of the door-to-door canvass last weekend and that copies of the petition

would be presented to Mr. O'Neill.

Another spokesman, John Brode of Citizens for Participation in Political Action, said that the petition drive would continue on Election Day next Tuesday. He said that volunteers would collect signatures at polling places in Boston, Cambridge and Somerville.
