

Brennan Raps Labor Drive For Impeachment

NEW YORK, Nov. 22 (AP)—
Labor Secretary Peter Brennan says it isn't "in the best interests of the labor movement to pour money and effort into impeachment activities."

Brennan told a group of union leaders Wednesday: "Labor should not lead these attacks. I think the President is going to be in office for the next three years, and it will not reflect favorably on the unions to join in these activities."

"The President is like anyone else," he said. "He could make mistakes like anyone else. But until that is proven in the proper way, we have to work with this administration."
