Delay in Saxbe Oath

Will Permit Pension

Sen. William B. Saxbe (R-Ohio), his confirmation as attorney general by the Senate assured, will delay his swearing-in until after the first of the year, when he will become eligible for a congressional pension of \$10,000 annually.

But William Hoiles, Saxbe's administrative assistant said yesterday the delay had nothing to do with the pension. He described it as a "fortunate occurrence and not the rationale."

On Jan. 3 Saxbe will have completed five years of his first term and will become vested in the pension program.
