

GOP Asks Timetable On Impeachment Probe

Republicans on the House Judiciary Committee called yesterday for a timetable for the investigation of grounds for the possible impeachment of President Nixon.

Airing their complaints on the House floor, the Republicans objected to what they described as one-man control of the investigation by Representative Peter Rodino (Dem-N.J.), the committee chairman.

Rodino has turned aside all criticism of the pace of

the investigation by declaring that no decisions about how it is to be conducted can be made until the special counsel is on the job.
