### Camp David, Md.

President Nixon spent a restful day with his family at this mountaintop retreat yesterday, and conferred several times by telephone with Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger about the Middle East peace negotiations in Geneva.

A White House spokesman said Mr. Nixon scheduled a meeting with Kissinger for tomorrow.

The secretary returned Saturday from Geneva, where he participated in the start of Arab-Israeli peace talks, winding up a 15-day, 13-nation journey through western Europe and the Middle East.

White House spokesman Gerald L. Warren said the

meeting between Mr. Nixon and Kissinger will be at the White House.

Mr. Nixon made the 70-mile trip to Camp David by car Saturday.

Staying with Mr. Nixon at the snow-covered Camp David retreat were Mrs. Nixon, daughter Tricia and son-in-law Edward Cox.

Plans called for a family celebration at the White House on Christmas Day, but presidential aides said Mr. Nixon still has not made a final decision on whether to go to his home in Key Biscayne, Fla., for a vacation through New Year's day.
