

Ehrlichman Trial Motions Postponed

LOS ANGELES, Dec. 26 (UPI)—A pre-trial hearing in the case of John Ehrlichman and two other former White House aides charged with burglary in the break-in at the office of Ellsberg's psychiatrist was postponed today until Jan. 14.

Lawyers for Ehrlichman, G. Gordon Liddy and David Young agreed in a private session in chambers to permit the prosecution the added time in turning over to the defense a list of witnesses it intends to call.

None of the defendants was in court today.

The trial itself is scheduled to start April 15.
