

*'Anxious' time*

SCOTTSDALE (Ariz.) — Katharine Graham, board chairman of the Washington Post, admitted yesterday to "moments of anxiety" when the White House denied the paper's early revelations of the Watergate scandal.

Mrs. Graham, accepting the John Peter Zenger Freedom of the Press Award, said the newspaper also underestimated "the extent and ferocity" of the administration's counterattacks.
