Quit for Nation

Washington

Senator Walter Mondale (Dem.-Minn.) said yesterday President Nixon should resign because he "has undermined his moral credibility to the point that he can no longer effectively lead the country."

Mondale, who is considering running for the Democratic presidential nomination in 1976, called on Mr. Nixon to step down in the best interests of the nation.

Mondale was interviewed on the NBC-TV "Today" show.
