

Venue Change for Trial In Knifing of FBI Man

George Session, the 18-year-old Mission High School senior charged with slashing the neck of an FBI agent in the Federal Building lobby, will have his trial heard in Sacramento instead of San Francisco.

U.S. District Judge Lloyd H. Burke yesterday granted a motion for a change of venue asked for by Assistant Public Defender Frank Bell.

Session was ordered to re-
port in Sacramento on Fe-

bruary 11 where a trial date will be set.

Session is charged with assault with intent to commit murder. On December 6 he and FBI agent Tom Hopkins accidentally brushed against one another as they were going through a door to the Federal Building.

According to the investigation, Session slashed Hopkins on the neck with a knife and Hopkins in turn shot Session.
