Speaker Says House Will Vote On Impeachment

Speaker Carl Albert (Dem-Okla.), said yesterday there will be a vote in the House on whether to impeach President Nixon regardless of what the Judiciary Committee does.

Albert noted there have been 18 impeachment resolutions introduced since July and such a resolution is "privileged," meaning its author can demand that it come to the floor for a vote by the full House even if the Judiciary Committee votes against it.
