Sources Say Rebozo Used Nixon Funds

Senate Watergate committee investigators have developed information that Charles G. (Bebe) Rebozo, President Nixon's close friend, may have converted presidential campaign money to his personal use, according to well placed committee officials.

Rebozo refused this week to turn over to the committee documents that the investigators believe would provide proof of the conversion.

Committee sources said their information had been obtained through a careful search of various financial records already in the committee's possession.

Officials said the amount of money is probably less than \$5000.

Rebozo could not be reached for comment yesterday.

The sources said they are not sure whether the money had been donated to Mr. Nixon's 1968 or 1972 campaigns, but they said there is clear evidence that transactions involving the money occurred as late as June, 1972.
