

Nixon Moved The Trailer

Camp David, Md.

President Nixon has ordered the removal of a press trailer here where reporters could observe his arrivals and departures, it was learned yesterday.

White House aides said the trailer, which cost an estimated \$30,000 to equip and install, was moved about 300 yards from the helicopter landing pad in early December. "There is no question where the orders came from," they said.

The disappearance of the trailer followed closely the tearing down a three-sided duck blind, also in early December, from which wire service reporters telephoned their offices after Mr. Nixon's landing and takeoffs.
