Setter Flew

In Nixon Plane

King Timahoe, President Nixon's Irish setter, recently flew to California in the President's airplane, not in a separate plane. Deputy White House press secretary Gerald L. Warren took time out the other day to make that point with listeners of WPGC, a Prince George's County rock music station.

Warren said in a Jan. 28 letter to the station's general manager, Robert Howard, that contrary to the comments of one listener on the "Sound Off" feature on WPGC, King Timahoe didn't follow the President to San Clemente in a government airplane.

"The President did take his Irish setter, King Timahoe, to California but King Timahoe rode on the United airliner (which carried the President) in the baggage compartment," Warren wrote.
