Ziegler Goes Before Jury For 2d Time

White House press secretary Ronald L. Ziegler made a second appearance before a federal grand jury this week but is "not a target" of the Watergate investigations, a White House spokesman said yesterday.

Deputy press secretary Gerald L. Warren said that Ziegler "did reappear" Tuesday before the original grand jury investigating the break-in and bugging of the Democratic National Committee headquarters in June, 1972.

The same grand jury is investigating erasures in a tape of a June 20, 1972, conversation between President Nixon and his former chief of staff, H. R. Haldeman.

When asked whether Ziegler was "a target" in the investigation and whether he had been so informed, Warren replied, "He has not been informed and he is not a target."

He said that Ziegler had not hired a lawyer for himself outside the White House.

"You mean he's going without legal advice?" Warren was asked.

"That's right," he replied.
