

Maryland Won't

Offer Agnew

Governor Marvin Mandel, who four months ago offered Maryland state police protection to Spiro T. Agnew, will not renew the offer now that Agnew has lost his secret service protection, Mandel's office said yesterday.

If Agnew requests state police protection, it will be handled routinely by the state police, like a request from any other citizen, according to Mandel's press secretary, Frank A. Defilippo.

The Treasury Department ended Agnew's secret service protection Sunday.
