Nixon Plans Series of Appearances

President Nixon is planning a series of public appearances in the next few weeks. The first is a speech this morning before the Young Republican leadership conference at the Shoreham Hotel.

On March 14 Mr. Nixon will fly to Chicago. He will meet with Mayor Richard Daley and on the 15th will make a speech and hold a question-and-answer session at the Executives Club. The club is made up of 3,500 business and professional men and women.

The following week, the President plans to visit Houston on the 19th to address the National Association of Broadcasters convention.

Tentatively scheduled but not yet officially announced by the White House is a visit to the Grand Ole Opry in Nashville on March 16.
