

Quit, GOP governor to Nixon

SEASIDE (Ore.) — Oregon Gov. Tom McCall, a Republican, has joined a long list of Democratic politicians in calling on President Nixon to resign rather than put the country through the agony of an impeachment trial.

McCall made his comments in a speech prepared for delivery today at the Republican Dorchester conference.

"The President is almost certain to be impeached and tried," McCall said, "and regardless of the outcome of the trial both he and the country will lose."

McCall said the President "has not come to the American people with open hands. He has not convinced us that salvaging the presidency is the issue — especially not when he may have been the creator of the damage."

McCall said Nixon has one last opportunity — "to give up all the information he has, all the tapes, all the memoranda."
