J. Fred Buzhardt, President Nixon's White House counsel, will testify Thursday in the Senate Armed Services Committee investigation of alleged military spying on the White House.

Chairman John C. Stennis (D-Miss.) said yesterday Buzhardt will stestify at a closed session and that the transcript will be made public after deletion of classified material.

Buzhardt was general counsel of the Defense Department in 1970-71 when Navy Yeoman Charles E. Radford admittedly rifled burn bags and briefcases to obtain National Security Council documents for transmission to the chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff.
