

Peek at His Plans

Special Watergate prosecutor Leon Jaworski plans at least a dozen more major indictments in the Watergate scandals, according to a letter sent to Judge John J. Sirica two months ago.

In addition, the special prosecutor told the judge, there will be a number of other guilty pleas by figures in the investigation.

Jaworski's plans were contained in an assessment made at the turn of the year at the request of Sirica so that he could plan the 1974 work load of the U.S. District Court here, of which Sirica is chief judge.

The Washington Star-News obtained a copy of the judge's memo and published it yesterday.

Sirica was clearly angry in his chambers yesterday when he found out about the newspaper's action.

However, when he spoke of the subject from the bench this afternoon, the flush was gone from his face and he called it "not an authorized disclosure."
