Diamond International Corp., a manufacturer of paper products and matches, pleaded guilty yesterday to making illegal contributions in the 1972 political campaign and was fined \$5000.

A vice president, Ray Dubrowin, also pleaded guilty in U.S. District Court

and was fined \$1000 on the misdemeanor count.

The firm admitted making illegal corporate contributions of \$5000 to the Finance Committee for the Re-election of th. President and \$1000 to the campaign of Democrat Edmund S. Muskie.
