'Repression' Seen

BOSTON, March 7 (AP) —The Rev. Billy Graham said today there will be repression in America unless political leaders restore the moral integrity undermined by Watergate and other social and political problems.

He told the 14th annual Governors' Prayer Breakfast here that "unless moral values are restored, the free way of life in America is doomed and will not survive this century, and maybe not this decade."

He said a lack of political integrity is the main reason for disillusionment among Americans.

"Every city and state—with the exception of Boston and Massachusetts—seems to be wrestling with its own private Watergate. Cynicism, disillusion and anger among common men threaten American freedom," Graham said.
