Nixon to Begin Trip Today
To Chicago and to Nashville

WASHINGTON, March 13 (UPI)—President Nixon leaves tomorrow for appearances in Chicago on Friday and Nashville on Saturday. He will then return to Washington and fly to Houston next Tuesday for another appearance.

The tour will begin with a luncheon speech Friday for the Executive Club in Chicago and end with an appearance Tuesday night before the National Association of Broadcasters in Houston.

Both sessions which will be nationally televised, will follow the news conference format that Mr. Nixon used during his appearance Nov. 17 before The Associated Press managing editors in Orlando, Fla.

Mr. Nixon will fly to Nashville Saturday for dedication of the new, \$25-million Grand Ole Opry Center and a reunion with his wife, on her return from a Latin-American tour.

The Nixons plan to return to Washington that night and attend a White House worship service Sunday led by the Rev. Dr. Norman Vincent Peale.
