

A Dispute Knocks

First Lady off TV

Washington

An appearance by First Lady Pat Nixon on ABC's "Issues and Answers" interview show tomorrow has been canceled because the White House and the television network could not agree on a format for the show, it was disclosed yesterday.

Industry sources said the White House wanted ABC to allow Mrs. Nixon to show movies and to narrate about her trip to South America, ABC wanted her to submit

to questions.

According to an ABC correspondent traveling with President Nixon in Chicago, presidential press secretary Ronald Ziegler rejected the question-and-answer format.

An ABC spokesman in Washington said, "We said no to the White House plan."

Israeli foreign minister Abba Eban will replace Mrs. Nixon as the guest on "Issues and Answers," ABC said.
