United Auto Workers President Leonard Wood-cock yesterday called on Congress to proceed with the impeachment of President Nixon, saying that is the only way to end the constitutioal crisis now facing the country.

Woodcock noted that until now he had favored Mr. Nixon's resignation, but said this would only leave the "myth of a martyred President."

"The Congress must do its duty and proceed with impeachment," he told 1000 cheering delegates to the annual legislative conference sponsored by the UAW and the Machinists Union.
