(UPI)—The trial of John D.
Ehrlichman, former White
House adviser on domestic affairs, on perjury charges is
scheduled to begin April 15.
That would make Mr. Ehrlichman the first former high
White House official to face a
jury for the Ellsberg burglary.
Mr. Ehrlichman is the only
one of the four original defendants who still faces trial in
a California court.

He is charged with lying to a
county grand jury when he
testified that he did not know in
advance that the White House
"plumbers" planned to rifle the
files of Daniel Ellsberg's former
psychiatrist.

The trial date was set yesterday in a conference involving
the prosecutor, Stephen Trott; a
defense attorney, Douglas Dalton, and Superior Court Judge
Gordon Ringer.
