**Nixon Weighs Release  
Of '73 Income Tax Data**

WASHINGTON, March 27  
(AP)—President Nixon has not yet decided whether to make public his Federal income tax return of 1973, Ronald L. Ziegler his press secretary, said today.

Asked by reporters about possible further disclosure of tax returns by Mr. Nixon, Mr. Ziegler remarked, "I don't see a great rush of other officials to follow the President's precedent" in disclosing their returns.

Saying this would "be a constructive step," he suggested that returns might be made public by Republican and Democratic leaders of Congress and by key members of Congressional committees. Asked if he was reflecting Mr. Nixon's view or his own, Mr. Ziegler said, "I'm musing out loud."
