The President flew here after making a speech in the rain at Ft. McNair in honor of Vietnam veterans.

Accompanying him are Mrs. Nixon and their daughter and son-in-law, Julie and David Eisenhower.

Also aboard the presidential aircraft were Roy L. Ash, director of the Office of Management and Budget, and Mrs. Ash, press secretary Ronald L. Ziegler, and Alexander M. Haig Jr., White House staff chief.

Ziegler declined to elaborate on an earlier statement announcing that the President was complying with the subpoena of Watergate Special Prosecutor Leon Jaworski for "materials" from White House files.
