

Help Proposed On Nixon's Taxes

DALLAS, April 6 (AP)—
A Dallas real estate man
said today that a group
backing President Nixon
is willing to buy the Presi-
dent's vice presidential
papers, giving Mr. Nixon
the money to pay back
taxes.

Otis Davenport said the
disputed papers would be
donated to Baylor Univer-
sity at Waco, Tex., for dis-
play.

Davenport identified him-
self as a consultant to the
National Committee To
Support the Presidency
and a member of Baylor's
Development Council. He
said the committee has
branches in 15 states, but
said he doesn't know its
membership.
