

Trial Date Set For Ehrlichman In Ellsberg Case

U.S. District Judge Gerhard A. Gesell yesterday set June 17 for the conspiracy trial of former presidential adviser John D. Ehrlichman and five others in connection with the Ellsberg break-in.

Charged along with Ehrlichman, President Nixon's former domestic affairs adviser, are Charles Colson, former special White House counsel; convicted Watergate burglar G. Gordon Liddy, and three Cuban-Americans, Bernard Barker, Eugenio Martinez and Felipe de Diego.
