Martha Says She's Unhappy

Martha Mitchell said Wednesday night she is a very "unhappy woman," who has been "restrained physically" from seeing her daughter and no longer recognizes her husband.

The estranged wife of former Attorney General John Mitchell appeared on the "Tomorrow Show" to say that she favors impeachment of President Nixon as a means "of bringing every-

thing out into the open."

Mrs. Mitchell was near tears when she said she had not seen her daughter Marty, 12, for many months.

"I have been restrained physically from seeing my daughter," she said after the show. "I cannot even reach her by telephone.

"I live from day to day. I was always a woman who planned my life and activities. Now, nothing is planned, and I don't know

what the future will bring. I am a very unhappy woman."
