Nixon plans journeys to south, west

CAMP DAVID, Md.— President Nixon is planning public appearances in Mississippi and Arizona in the next two weeks as part of his campaign to blunt impeachment moves, sources reported yesterday.

As the President was spending the weekend in the seclusion of his mountaintop retreat, sources in Washington disclosed the tentative schedule for the journeys into regions generally considered friendly to his cause.

The sources said Nixon had scheduled a speech before a regional economic council in Jackson, Miss., next Thursday, and another speech in Phoenix, May 2.
