

Case Bids Nixon Quit If His Trial Is Delayed

Senator Clifford Case, Republican of New Jersey said that President Nixon should resign if the House decides to vote for impeachment but does not get the matter "over to the Senate for trial within a few months," United Press International reported yesterday.

The Senator, in an interview on the WABC radio program "Press Conference," said, "I don't think that the uncertainty that the country has gone through and the tension and the concentration on this single issue is a very good thing."

Asked whether he felt that President Nixon could still govern effectively in light of the Watergate scandal, Senator Case said the President, "is, without much question, weaker."

But he added, "I'm not sure this is bad. We've had too much of the business of Presidential determination of everything and too much acceptance by the public and also by Congress."
