

It Means More Work For Ervin Committee

The sudden release of President Nixon's recorded conversations has strained the resources of the Senate Watergate committee and, according to some sources, may delay the panel's final report.

Samuel Dash, the committee's chief counsel, said yesterday the May 28 target date will be met.

But he said that the infor-

mation in the transcripts plus any new material developed by continuing investigations may result in a supplementary report at a later date.

"This is an unverified account and because of that, the weight to be given to it will have to be seriously considered," one committee lawyer said of the edited and censored transcript released by the White House.
