TV Coverage Set

For House Hearings

NEW YORK, May 7 (UPI) — The three major television networks officially announced today they have decided to rotate their live coverage of the House Judiciary Committee hearings on the question of impeaching President Nixon.

Under the agreement, live coverage will rotate alphabetically, beginning with the American Broadcasting Co., then Columbia Broadcasting System and finally the National Broadcasting Co.

The House inquiry is expected to begin within two weeks.

The Public Broadcasting System announced Friday it would cover the hearings on a delayed videotape basis during the evening, as it did during the Senate hearings last summer and fall.
