Former Cox Aide Named

To Watergate Trial Post

WASHINGTON, May 7
(AP)—James F. Neal, who headed the Watergate coverup investigation last year when Archibald Cox was the special prosecution team as chief trial lawyer, it was announced Tuesday.

Leon Jaworski, who succeeded Mr. Cox as special prosecutor, said that Mr. Neal would be in charge of the coverup conspiracy trial of seven former aides of President Nixon, now scheduled to begin on Sept. 9.

Mr. Neal, 44 years old chief of the Watergate investigative force for five months, returned to private law practice in Nashville last Oct. 19, one day before Mr. Cox was discharged by President Nixon.
