

**Sentencing of Magruder
Is Scheduled for May 21**

WASHINGTON, May 9 (AP) —May 21 has been set as the date for sentencing Jeb Stuart Magruder, former deputy director of President Nixon's 1972 campaign committee, who pleaded to conspiring to obstruct justice in a Watergate case.

Federal District Judge John J. Sirica set the date for the former White House aide, who faces a maximum sentence of five years in prison and a \$10,000 fine.

Mr. Magruder, 39 years old, pleaded guilty Aug. 16. He said he had helped plan the break-in and bugging of Democratic National Committee headquarters in the Watergate complex.
